The Deceit of Prosperity

The proud person takes credit for accomplishments and takes glory for themselves that belongs only to God. (30)

The irony is that we are made in the image of God. But when we will not acknowledge and worship Him, we become less than ourselves. Worshipping ourselves, the creature rather than the Creator, we become less than human, not more human. Humanism is dehumanizing.

Nebuchadnezzar was restored when he lifted his eyes to heaven and acknowledged that the Most High is the eternal, sovereign, absolute ruler.
