



### Hearing loss can lead to death.

Can we lose our salvation? Not if we are truly saved.

1. Who are these people?
2. What does it mean to “turn away?”
3. Why is it impossible to bring such people back to repentance?

I. Look at the context first.

- A. The farmer and the field. The rain and the ground. (7-8)
- B. The Israelites at the edge of the Promised Land. (3:7-19)
- C. You have become dull of hearing. (5:11)

II. Exposure is not acceptance. Hearing is not believing.

To turn to God means:

- o Repentance: turning from sin to God (6:1c)
- o Trust the sufficiency of Jesus’ sacrifice (as High Priest) on your behalf.
- o Perseverance: 3:14; 6:11-12
- o Fruit (6:7-8)

To turn away means:

Having heard, tasted, experienced God’s goodness, and seen God’s powerful work of transforming lives, you decide you can’t/won’t trust Him for your eternal future.

III. There is no plan b or c.

How does this apply to me?
