

The excellence and high position of Melchizedek as king and priest point to the <u>supremacy</u> of Jesus as High King and High Priest.

- I. Abraham gave Melchizedek a tithe. (4-6a)
- II. Melchizedek blessed Abraham. (6b-7)
- III. <u>Duration</u> of Melchizedek's order. (8)

The supremacy of Jesus Christ as High King and High Priest means that those who are <u>in Christ</u> are supremely secure.

Corporate solidarity. (9-10)

- I. In Adam, all are <u>sinners</u> and <u>die</u>. (Romans 5:12)
- II. In Jesus, all can be made <u>righteous</u> and <u>alive</u>. (Rom 5:19; Ephesians 2:1, 4-7)
