## Paul Threatened and Paul Before Felix

I. Promise	Acts 23:11	Paul is frightened but the Lord sends him a message.
II. Plot	Acts:23:12-22	The religious leaders plot against Paul, but God uses a Roman soldier, Claudius Lysias, and Paul's nephew to protect him
III. Protection	Acts 23:23-35	The Lord continues to protect Paul through the work of Lysias and a few hundred Roman soldiers
IV. Prosecution	Acts 24:1-9	Ananias, Tertullus, and other Jewish leaders try to persuade Felix, the governor, that Paul has violated Roman law
V. Protestation	Acts 24:10-21	Paul makes his defense
VI. Procrastination	Acts 24:22-27	Felix is reluctant to make a decision because he wants to keep on good terms with the Jewish leaders
