- It means *to prostrate oneself in homage before another in a full sense of worship, not mere reverence or courtesy*
- It represents *the most common Near Eastern act of adoration and reverence and also carries the idea of profound awe and respect*
- It is *to fall upon the knees and touch the ground with the forehead as an expression of profound reverence*
