PASSAGE OVERVIEW

God is for you. Consider that! If you have trusted Jesus as your Savior, you have peace with God. There is no condemnation leveled against you anymore. You've been adopted. You are an heir. The Father gave His Son for you. This is the ultimate gift. This is the greatest act of love ever. Who then would dare come against you? God is for you.
