

11 For I know the <u>plans</u> I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for <u>welfare</u> and not for <u>evil</u>, to give you a <u>future</u> and a hope.

(NIV - "plans to prosper you and not to harm you")

12 Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will <u>hear</u> you. 13 You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart.

14 I will be <u>found</u> by you, declares the LORD, and I will <u>restore</u> your fortunes (NIV – "bring you back from captivity") and gather you from all the nations and all the places where I have driven you, declares the LORD, and I will bring you back to the place from which I sent you into exile.

- 1. Be **AWESTRUCK** by what the LORD declares
- 2. Be **AWARE** of what is not promised
- 3. Be ATTENTIVE to the historical context
- 4. Be **INTENTIONAL** about making this personal
 - * the LORD <u>affirms</u> for us *He knows THE plan*
 - * the LORD <u>asks</u> of us call, pray, seek Him with a whole heart
 - * the LORD <u>requires</u> of us that we wait on/for Him
 - * the LORD <u>promises</u> for us forgiveness, restoration
